



Read John 21:1-14

What is significant about Peter wanting to go fishing?
See Matthew 4:18-20 (fisherman)



How well is the fishing “that night?” When do they begin to catch fish?

Assemble the theological message:
Where else have we seen Peter around a charcoal fire?
See John 18:17-18, 25-27 (fire)

Where else have we seen a strange abundance provided by Jesus, not to mention a meal of bread and fish?
See John 2:6-10 (wine)
See John 6:10-13 (fish)

Why bring the fish to Jesus if he’s already prepared some for them to eat?
See John 14:6 (way)

Note who leads the charge to drag the untorn net to Jesus.

What does the language of verse 13 remind you of?
Matthew 26:26-28 (eat)

Read John 21:15-19

Does Simon love Jesus more than what?

What is Jesus calling on Peter to do?

See John 10 (shepherd)

What is the end result of this conversation? What do vs. 18-19 have to do with it?

See John 13:37-38 (life)

See John 12:33 (death)

Read John 21:20-25

What does this passage tell us about the beloved disciple?

How does the disciple end his Gospel?
